New This Season: Bring a book – take a book. We are now offering a book exchange for any of your previously read novels.

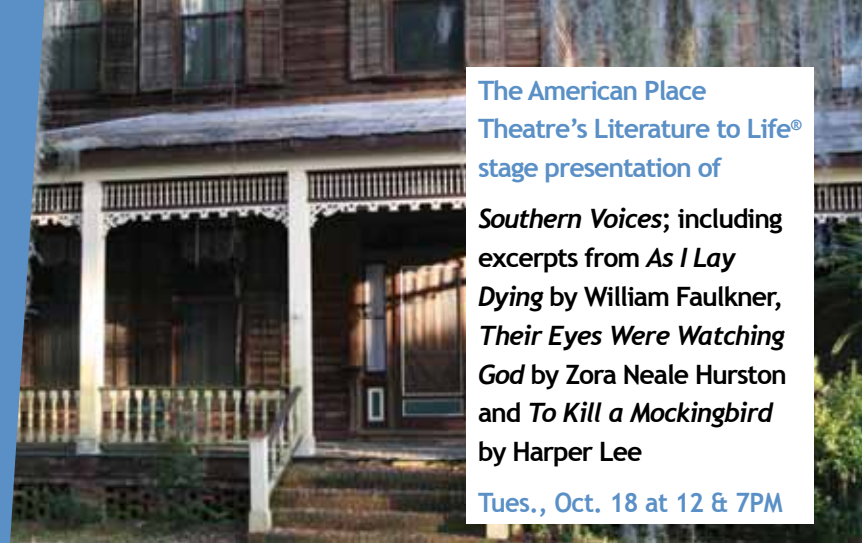

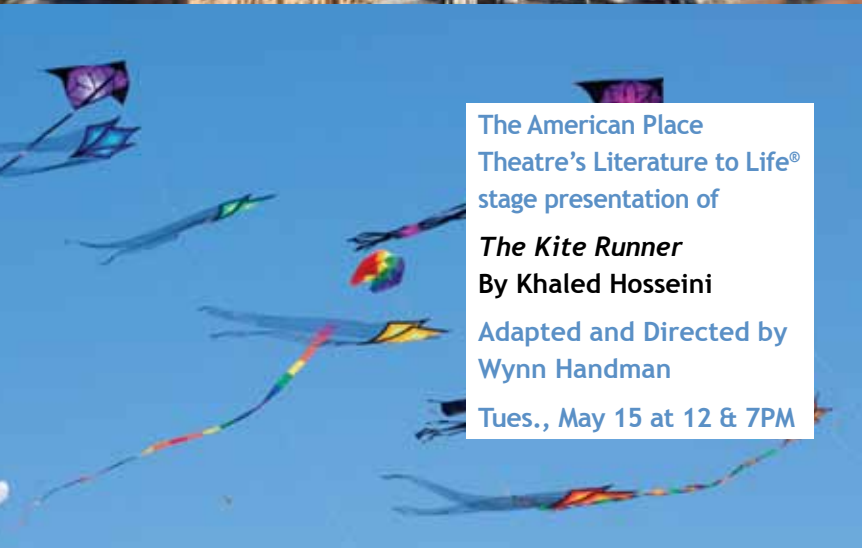
